



USSU / CFCR Radio Show Policy

1.

Preamble

The USSU has developed a relationship with CFCR Community Radio where USSU representatives host a radio show that highlights student issues. This endeavour helps to reach out to students and the community at large.

2.

Procedures

At the beginning of the term, the VP Student Affairs is responsible for contacting the Programming Manager for CFCR and determining the details of the show for the upcoming academic year. These specifics include the time of day, the day of the week, the total allotted amount of time for the show, and the fees required from the USSU.

3.

Radio Show Host

3.1 The VP Student Affairs may find, through a hiring process, a suitable volunteer to host the radio show. In the interim period, the VP Student Affairs, or designate, will be responsible for hosting the radio show.

3.2 The VP Student Affairs or designated host will be responsible for finding weekly information on student life and USSU events.

3.3 The radio show host must report to and is responsible to the VP Student Affairs.

3.4 If, for whatever reason, the position of radio show host becomes vacant, the VP Student Affairs will be responsible for finding a suitable replacement by completing the hiring process.
