- 13. For the purposes of this Bylaw the Executive is understood to be the Board of Directors as specified in the Article of Incorporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Act or any successor legislation.
 - (1) The Executive has the right, as needed, to amend position profiles for officer positions. These profiles will reside in the USSU's Shared Files and on the USSU website. Members shall elect, for a one-year term, an Executive composed of:
