What are your Responsibilities when using Al?

As students, using Generative Artificial Intelligence (GenAl) like ChatGPT is common. However, we have to know University expectations if we are using AI for course work.



👤 Your Responsibilities Are:

- Ask for help and clarification when confused.
- Learn what each instructor's expectations are AND keep track of the various expectations across all your courses.
- Learn to use AI to help your learning, not replace it. Recognize 3. when you are using AI, and evaluate the content produced by Al. In Al-generated content, check and edit for bias, accuracy, and relevance.
 - Use AI Responsibly. Make sure to cite AI properly when you do use it. (Remember, if you do not cite Al properly, or do not follow your instructors' rules, you could face academic misconduct allegations).
 - Protect yourself (your privacy and security). Many Al tools retain what you put into them, so only work that has the permission of the creator can be put into AI. Use USask approved AI tools, like Copilot (accessed through PAWS).
