What are your
Responsibilities
when using AI?

As students, using Generative Artificial Intelligence (GenAI) like ChatGPT is common. However, we have to know University expectations if we are using AI for course work.



Your Responsibilities Are:

1. Ask for help and clarification when confused.
2. Learn what each instructor's expectations are AND keep track of the various expectations across all your courses.
3. Learn to use AI to help your learning, not replace it. Recognize when you are using AI, and evaluate the content produced by AI. In AI-generated content, check and edit for bias, accuracy, and relevance.
4. Use AI Responsibly. Make sure to cite AI properly when you do use it. (Remember, if you do not cite AI properly, or do not follow your instructors' rules, you could face academic misconduct allegations).
5. Protect yourself (your privacy and security). Many AI tools retain what you put into them, so only work that has the permission of the creator can be put into AI. Use USask approved AI tools, like Copilot (accessed through PAWS).
