60. The Chief Returning Officer shall release results to candidates, students, and media at a place and time as set out in the Election or By-Election Schedule, and shall cause the results to be posted on the Union website immediately.

Proposed Amendment

- 60. The Chief Returning Officer shall oversee the results of the election in accordance with the following procedures:
 - i. Each presidential candidate may appoint one scrutineer to observe the validation and tallying of results by the Chief Returning Officer and the Elections Committee.
- ii. The Chief Returning Officer shall release the results to candidates, students, and media at a place and time as set out in the Election or By-Election Schedule.
- iii. The results shall be posted on the Union website immediately following their release.
