

Whereas, the Saskatchewan's Education (Parents' Bill of Rights) Amendment Act (Bill 137) proposes changes that may undermine the inclusivity and safety of educational environments for trans students;

Whereas, such legislative changes may significantly impact the mental health and well-being of students, particularly those from marginalized communities;

Whereas, the proposed legislation is the use of the notwithstanding clause threatens the rule of order and our basic Charter freedoms, undermining fundamental rights protected under the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms;

Be it resolved that:

- The USSU Executives shall draft and send a formal letter expressing opposition to Bill 137 to the Premier of Saskatchewan, the Minister of Education, and the Minister of Mental Health.
