Whereas:

- The undergraduate wage salary grid has not been increased or reviewed in over ten years and is no longer reflective of comparable salary rates and the cost of living.
- Minimum wage has cut out the lowest amounts of the grid but it has never increased.
- Professional college students, although classified as undergraduates, take on similar positions to graduate students and should therefore receive equal pay for equal work.

Therefore, be it resolved that:

- 1. The USSU executive and council will conduct a review of undergraduate student wages and advocate for increases in the salary.
- 2. The USSU will write a letter to the President of the university to advocate for the increase of undergraduate wages.
